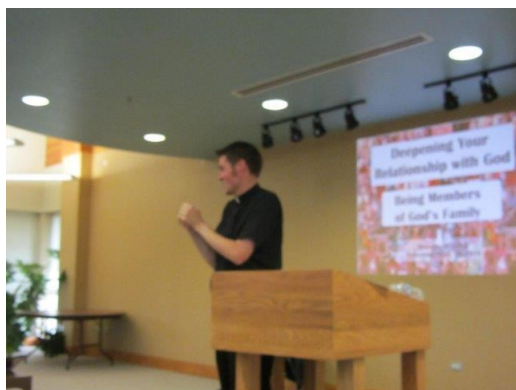
Jack Crotty welcomed brothers and sisters for the Deaf Retreat Day.

Fr Mark Fracaro explained what we would have for lunch for the day.

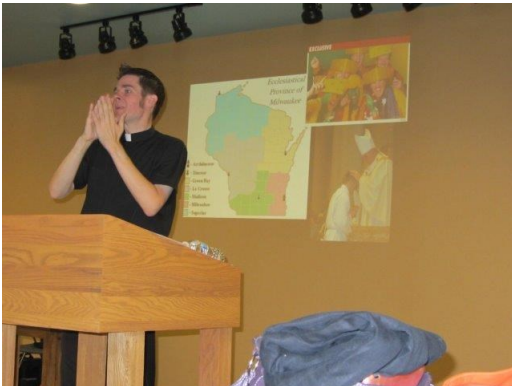
