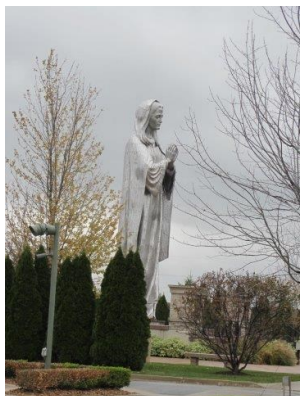

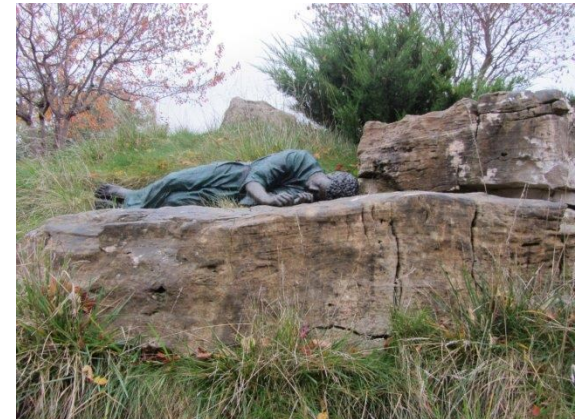
**The Last Supper with Jesus.**

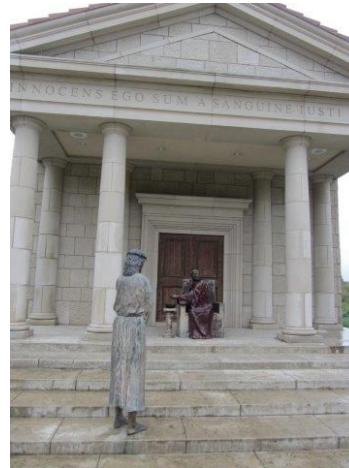
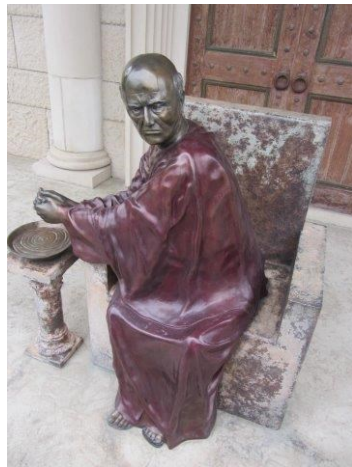

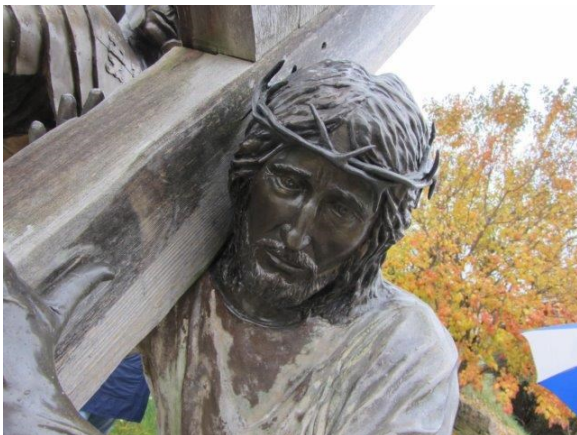


**Jesus with hands tied with ropes standing before Pontius Pilate while Pontius is washing his hands.**

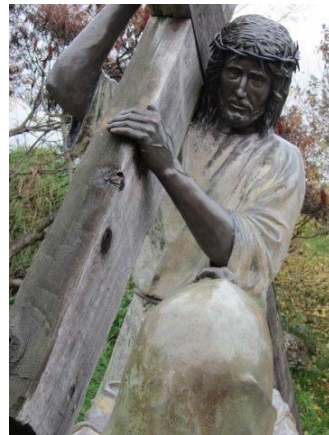

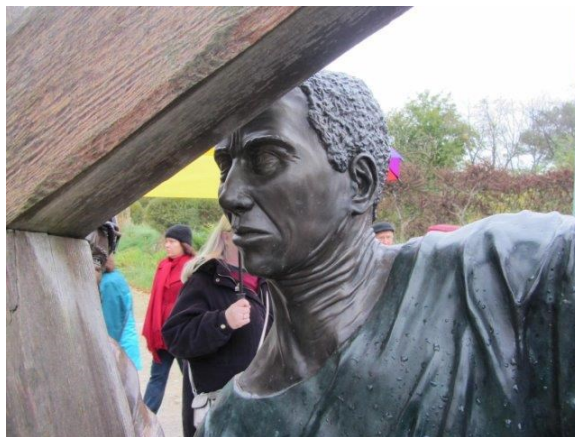

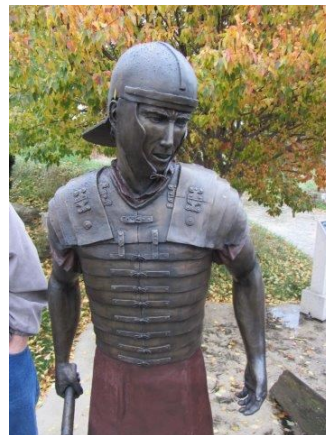

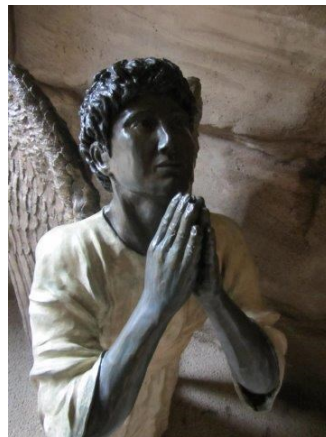

This place invites you to get real experience of Jesus's Passion as never before you have feeling like. There are 40 life size bronze statues, each beautiful works of art and description that describes the scene. As you exit the tomb of Jesus and continue down the path, you will find Jesus meeting Mary Magdalene and even experience His glorious Ascension to Heaven. The tour is handicap accessible and will provide limited seats on motorized carts for you who unable to walk far. Most of the beautiful Shrine are outside. Please wear comfortable shoes for long walking. There have the Visitor Center and Religion Store.

For our tour with our 2 Interpreters will take about 2 ½ hours

After we finish the tour, we can go out for dinner at Aurelio's Pizza at 1412 Lincoln Hwy., Schererville, Indiana (15 minutes drive from the Shrine).
